## PORTS OF CALL

### **Salaverry, Peru**

Salaverry is a jumping-off point to the fascinating cities of Trujillo, surrounded by pre-Incan archaeological sites, and Chan Chan, the largest pre-Columbian city in South America.

### **Guayaquil, Ecuador**

On the Guayas River and near the Equator, Guayaquil springs to life as the largest city and main port of Ecuador. At the Malecón, the city's riverfront promenade, shopping and sightseeing go hand in hand among the dynamic spirit of the locals.

### **Manta, Ecuador**

Once a trading port for the pre-Columbian Mateña people, Manta—their namesake—has evolved into a bustling seaport and is considered the gateway to Ecuador.

### **Fuerte Amador (Balboa), Panama**

On the Pacific side of the Panama Canal, this lively port is a peninsula that connects four small islands to the mainland. Nearby, in cosmopolitan Panama City, is the historic district of Casco Viejo, known for its beautiful French and Spanish colonial homes.

### **Panama Canal Transit**

Enter the Panama Canal for a crossing through the famed waterway and engineering marvel that connects the Pacific and Atlantic oceans.

### **Puerto Limon, Costa Rica**

On the vibrant and flourishing Caribbean coast, Puerto Limon boasts a strong Afro-Caribbean culture and a gateway to Costa Rica's idyllic tropical splendor.

### **Roatan, Honduras**

On the southern edge of the world's second-largest barrier reef, Roatan is celebrated for its superb snorkeling and diving.

### **Santo Tomas, Guatemala**

The port of Santo Tomas is a gateway to the ruins of Quirigua with its impressive Mayan stelae and the wild beauty of Rio Dulce, a river edged by lush foliage.
