Depart 5PM

AUG 5: KETCHIKAN, ALASKA

Arrive 9AM—Depart 5PM

Built around salmon canneries and sawmills, Ketchikan was once proclaimed the Salmon Capital of the World. Its unique culture is celebrated through its renowned collection of totem poles, an accolade to Native art. Situated at the foot of Deer Mountain, Ketchikan is backed by steep, forested slopes and fringed by a pristine waterfront, creating an impossibly beautiful backdrop. Not far in the distance is the Tongass National Forest—the nation's largest—abundant with wildlife and the peaceful aura of the North Country.

AUG 6: ICY STRAIT POINT (HOONAH), ALASKA

Arrive 11AM—Depart 10PM

Wilderness and tribal traditions intertwine in Icy Strait Point. Its notable cannery dates back to 1930, offering a glimpse into Alaska's more recent history, while bears, eagles and humpback whales make up a population that outnumbers everyone. Just over a mile away, is culturally-rich Hoonah, a Tlingit fishing village for hundreds of years and home to the largest Native settlement in Alaska.

AUG 7: CRUISING HUBBARD GLACIER

A journey to Alaska would not be complete without viewing the majestic Hubbard Glacier. As Alaska's longest tidewater glacier, its unrivaled proportions stretch over six miles, offering dramatic vistas of sparkling blue ice. As the towering glacier moves and calves, crashing chunks of ice fall into the bay and create a sound called 'white thunder' by the Tlingit people.

AUG 8: SKAGWAY, ALASKA

Arrive 9AM—Depart 6PM

Skagway, located at the northwest end of the Alaska Marine Highway, was known to thousands of hopeful gold rushers as the gateway to the gold fields. Today this delightful town retains the flavor of the gold rush era and the character of colorful inhabitants such as Soapy Smith, the "King of the Frontier Con Men," especially on Broadway, with its false-front buildings and in the Trail of '98 Museum, with its outstanding collection of gold fever memorabilia.

AUG 9: SITKA, ALASKA

Arrive 10AM—Depart 8PM

Historically significant and vibrantly multicultural, Sitka is not only the storyteller of some of the state's most compelling history, but breathtakingly beautiful as well. First called Shee Atika by the Tlingit Indians, and then New Archangel by the Russians who ousted them, this city claims itself the cultural center of southeast Alaska. Its fascinating museums house some of the state's oldest native culture collections, while the Sitka National Historical Park boasts totem-lined forest trails and authentic artisan exhibits.

Shore excursions are not included. In each port of call you may select from a variety of optional shore excursions for an additional charge, some of which are referenced in the descriptions above. Once a Tlingit Indian stronghold, then a Russian settlement, later a British trading post, and ultimately purchased by the U.S., Wrangell commemorates the changes it has endured. Its museum offers insight into the three gold rushes that transformed the area and a glimpse of its native past can be found at a traditional Tlingit tribal house.
